<u>TUESDAY – MAY 7TH</u> HEBREWS 1:1-14 *LEARN JOHN 3:19*

- 1. What does the phrase 'sundry times and divers manners' mean?
- 2. What does it refer to in verse 1 that God spoke 'in time past to the fathers by the prophets'?
- 3. What does it refer to in verse 2 that He has spoken 'in these last days unto us by His Son'?
- 4. What is the significance of the statement that God has appointed the Son 'heir of all things'?
- 5. Explain what the following mean about Jesus...
 - a. He is the brightness of (God's) glory...
 - b. He is the express image of (God's) person...
- 6. What does it mean that Jesus 'upholds all things by the word of His power'?
- 7. What did Jesus do with our sins (all by Himself)?
- 8. What did He do once He had done this (your answer to #7)?
- 9. What, according to verse 4, sets Jesus apart as being so much better than the angels?
- 10. What did God tell the angels to when He brought His firstbegotten Son into the world?
- 11. Sum up what God, according to verse 8, told His son.
- 12. What has Jesus loved, and what has He hated?
- 13. Who does verse 10 say laid the foundation of the earth in the beginning?

14. How do verses 11 and 12 contrast the creation with the Creator?

<u>WEDNESDAY – MAY 8TH</u> HEBREWS 2:1-10 *LEARN JOHN 3:19*

- 1. What does verse 1 tell us to take heed of and why?
- 2. What does 'the word spoken by angels' refer to?
- 3. How is the word spoken by angels described in verse 2?
- 4. How does verse 3 say the word (about salvation) had been transmitted?
- 5. How was the word verified (authenticated)?
- 6. What, according to verse 5, has God not put in subjection to the angels?
- 7. Sum up what verses 7 & 8 say about God's creation of man.
- 8. What does it mean in verse eight that 'now we see not yet all things put under him'?
- 9. What does verse nine say that lets us know that the authority of Christ is greater than that of man?
- 10. Explain what verse ten says was befitting of Christ (it became Him).

<u>THURSDAY – MAY 9TH</u> LUKE 2:8-16 *LEARN JOHN 3:19*

- 1. What, according to verse 8, were the shepherds doing?
- 2. What happened as the shepherds were engaged in this (your answer to #1)?
- 3. How did the shepherds respond to what happened?
- 4. What is the very first thing the angel address to the shepherds?
- 5. What does the angel tell them he came to proclaim?
- 6. What place does the 'city of David' refer to?

- 7. Who does the angel say was born in the city of David that day?
- 8. What was to be the sign to the shepherds that they had found who they were looking for?
- 9. Who suddenly appeared with the angel who addressed the shepherds?
- 10. What were they (your answer to #9) doing and how were they doing it?
- 11. What happened when the angels completed what they were to do?
- 12. What did the shepherds do with the knowledge they had gained?

<u>FRIDAY – MAY 10th</u> MATTHEW 4:8-11; LUKE 22:39-46 *LEARN JOHN 3:19*

- 1. Where does the devil take Jesus to?
- 2. For what purpose does he take Jesus there?
- 3. What does the devil promise to do for Jesus?
- 4. Why is it wise to never believe the devil's promises?
- 5. What was the stipulation the devil had attached to his 'promise' to Jesus?
- 6. Sum up what Jesus tells the devil to do and why.
- 7. How does the devil respond to what Jesus says?
- 8. What happens after this temptation experience is over?
- 9. Look at Luke 22:39; what does it mean that Jesus was 'wont' to go to the mount of Olives?
- 10. Explain what Jesus tells His disciples to pray for in verse 40.
- 11. How far did Jesus remove Himself from the disciples to kneel down and pray?
- 12. What 'cup' is Jesus referring to that He asks His Father to remove from Him?

- 13. Although Jesus prayed for the cup to be removed, what does He do to show complete submission to His Father?
- 14. Who came to strengthen Jesus at this time?
- 15. How is the agony in which Jesus prays described?
- 16. What did Jesus 'find' when He had finished praying?
- 17. What have you learned about the Son that makes Him greater than the angels?
