4. What happened, according to verse 43, when Jesus’ parents left Jerusalem to head home?

5. What did Jesus’ parents do after a full day’s travel towards home?

6. How long was it before Jesus’ parents found Him?

7. Where was Jesus and what was He doing when they found Him?

8. Why was everyone who heard Jesus astonished?

9. Sum up what Mary asks Jesus when they see Him.

10. Now sum up Jesus’ response to His mother.

11. How do Jesus’ parents react to the statement He makes to His mother?

12. Where did Jesus and His parents go after they left Jerusalem?

13. What does it mean that Jesus was ‘subject’ to His parents?

14. How does verse 52 describe Jesus’ growth/maturity?

WEDNESDAY – MARCH 15TH

JOHN 5:16-29 LEARN JEREMIAH 13:23

1. Look at verse 16, why did the Jews persecute Jesus and try to kill Him?

2. Explain how Jesus addresses the Jews in verse 17.

3. Why did the Jews seek even harder at this point to kill Jesus?

4. Sum up how Jesus describes the way He and the Father work in verse 19.

5. What, according to verse 20, does the Father show the Son and why?

6. What great/amazing word does Jesus attribute to the Father and Son in verse 21?

7. What does verse 22 say the Father does not do?

8. What does verse 22 say the Father has done?

9. Why, according to verse 23, has the Father done this (your answer to #8)?

10. Who, according to verse 24, has everlasting life?

11. What does it mean that they 'shall not come into condemnation; but is passed from death unto life'?

12. Explain verse 25 in context.

13. What does the Father have in Himself?

14. What, according to verses 26 and 27, has the Father given to the Son?

15. What does Jesus say will happen when all that are in the grave hear His voice?

16. What will happen to those who have done good?

17. What will happen to those who have done evil?

THURSDAY - MARCH 16TH
JOHN 5:30-47 LEARN JEREMIAH 13:23

1. Explain how Jesus describes His judgment in verse 30.

2. What is it that Jesus says He seeks in verse 30?

3. What did Jesus say would be the case if He bore witness (testified) of Himself?

4. Who was the person who bore witness of the truth?

5. What does Jesus say about John in verse 35?

6. What is the witness (of who Jesus is) that is greater than John's testimony according to verse 36?

7. What other witness (that is greater than any human testimony) did Jesus say had borne witness of Him?

8. Why does Jesus say the Jews don't have God's word abiding in them?

9. Why were the Jews searching the scriptures?

10. What did Jesus say the scriptures really point to/testify of?

11. Explain verse 40 in context.

12. What does Jesus say He knows about the Jews?

13. Whose name does Jesus say He came in and what response did it get from the Jews?

14. Whose name did Jesus say someone else could come in and what response would it get from the Jews?

15. Who does Jesus say will accuse the Jews before God?

16. What does Jesus say would have really happened if the Jews had really believed Moses and why?

17. Explain verse 47 in context.

1. Who did Jesus see as He walked along?

2. What did the disciples inquire of Jesus concerning the person Jesus saw?

3. Sum up Jesus' answer to their question.

4. What does Jesus mean when He says 'I must work the work of Him that sent me while it is day'?

5. What does He mean 'the night cometh when no man can work'?

6. What does Jesus do in order for the blind man to be healed?

7. What happened when the blind man did what Jesus instructed?

8. Why is it important that we do what God has given us to do (work the work of Him that sent us)?

9. Look at James 2:17 and explain what James says about faith and works.
